Trail Closure - McLaren Rd. Bridge Rehabilitation

McLaren Road south of Forks of the Credit Road, Caledon

Commencing Wednesday, June 1st, 2016

McLaren Road south of Forks of the Credit Road will be closed from Wednesday June 1st 2016 until late October or November for the Credit River bridge rehabilitation. The side trail on McLaren Road crosses the bridge under re-construction. The bridge rehabilitation cannot be staged in a way to maintain access through it, and will be closed to all traffic (foot and vehicular) during the work. This means that the McLaren Road Side Trail will be closed at the bridge. The off road portion of trail will be maintained for in and out treks.
