Effective April 26, 2017

Earlier this month, our trail team finalized the re-blazing of our trails within Forks of the Credit Provincial Park. Because the viewing platform is closed for the foreseeable future, Quarryman's Side Trail has become main trail. The two stubs of the former main trail that went to the viewing platform, from below and above the falls of the cataract have been rebranded as side trails. The one in the valley is Cataract Side Trail. The one on the ridge and then going down to the foot of the stairs is Mill Pond Side Trail.

Cedar Brook Farm in Puslinch, 812 8th Concession Road West

May 17, 24, and 25, 2017

Bluebird Walks at Cedar Brook Farm with Dan Welsh. Meet at Cedar Brook Farm in Puslinch. The farm is located at 812 8th Concession Rd West. This is west of Hwy #6, just north of the traffic lights at Carlisle Rd. On 8th Concession drive up a steep hill and down to the bottom of the hill. Turn left at 812 at the Cedar Brook sign. Continue down the laneway to the second house. We will do a nature walk around the farm, discussing bluebirds, tree swallows and many other birds. If you want to feed the farm animals bring carrots. You can check out the Old Irish Home. Bring snack, water, bug spray, sunscreen. Pace: slow. Terrain: easy.
