**Thursday May 2: Caledon Hills Section,
Tall Timbers and Gosling Nature Reserve, Map 18,
Nature Walks,**

This less than 5 km hike will take approximately 3 hours and is at a leisurely pace over easy terrain. There is no dropout point. No dogs please. There will be a refreshment/pub stop afterwards.

Depart: 9:00 a.m. Parking lot on north side of 5 Sideroad Mono – km 44.3

GPS Coordinates: 43.974055 -79.984988

Directions: Airport Road north of Mono Mills to 5 Sideroad Mono. Turn east on 5 Sideroad for about 500 metres to parking lot on left (north side of road)

Hike Description: Enjoy a nature walk on one of the BTC's latest acquisitions, Tall Timbers, followed by a walk on the Gosling Nature Reserve. Look for bluebirds and other meadow birds. Bring your binoculars, cameras and nature guides and help identify flora and fauna on these two BTC properties.

OR

Hwy 10 to Hockley Road (north of Orangeville), then east to 5th Line EHS, south on 5th Line to parking.

This less than 5 km loop hike will take approximately 3 hours and is at a leisurely pace over moderate terrain.

Depart: 9:00 a.m. Roadside parking at km 53.9 on the 4th Line EHS at the entrance to the Peter Beecham Side Trail. Room for 5 cars.

Directions: Airport Road (Dufferin Road 18) to Hockley Valley Road, then west to 4th Line EHS and south on 4th Line to parking on west side of road.

OR

Highway 10 to Hockley Road, then east on Hockley Road to 4th Line EHS and south on 4th Line to parking on west side of 4th line.

Hike Description: This is the third in the Nature Walk series and will take place on the BTC's Griffith Ravine, a beautiful wooded property in the Hockley Valley. Bring binoculars, camera and nature guides in order to identify and record flora and fauna of this nature reserve.
