BTC Hiking Program

The BTC Hiking Program is resuming in concert with Ontario's three-step plan for reopening. While the Province is in Step 1, hikes are open to BTC members only with a limit of 10 hikers. Registration is required. The timing of each Step will be determined by the Province.



STEP 1:

- Hikes open for BTC Members only. Group size limited to 10. Registration required.
- Hikers should maintain 2m/6ft distance. Wearing masks is strongly recommended.
- No car shuttles or bus hikes are permitted.

STEP 2:

- Hikes open for BTC Members and guests. Group size limited to 25. Registration required.
- Hikers should maintain 2m/6ft distance. Wearing masks is strongly recommended.
- No car shuttles or bus hikes are permitted.

STEP 3:

- Hikes will be open to BTC Members and non-members with no capacity restrictions, unless outdoor capacity limits are put in place by the Province for Step 3.
- Car shuttles and bus hikes may resume.
- Group End-to-End hikes may resume.
- Event hikes may resume.
