The Winter Marketplace Checkout Process

We have used a 'traditional shopping' cart app for our Winter Marketplace. Due to the nature of how our Marketplace functions, there are some irregularities that we could not remove from the system. (And we didn't want to spend any money!)

The checkout process is as follows:

1. Once at the Marketplace site (caledonbrucetrail.ca/market), select "**Create an Account**".




2. Fill out the details as expected. Please note the final question "Desired Pick-up Location". **Please select one Pick-Up location.** Your purchases can be made available at one of the following four Pick-Up locations.

Brampton (Steeles Ave & Bramalea Rd area)
Mono (Airport Rd & HWY 9 area)
Guelph (Arboretum area)
Toronto (Avenue Rd & St.Clair area)

3. **Go Shopping!** You can select from the Categories on the top left. **Note:** We wanted to honour the Artisans who generously donated to the Winter Marketplace. The only way to do that was to include them as items listed under Artisan Biographies. The Artisans are not for sale. :)

4. Once you have finished shopping select the **Checkout** button on the bottom right side.



5. The first screen is the “Shipping” Screen. It is not applicable but could not be removed. All items are for pick-up only. Please just select **Continue** and advance to the next screen.

6. All payments must be made via e-transfer when your order is complete (see step #8.) Ignore the “Cash on Delivery” payment method which could not be removed.

In the “**Add Comments About Your Order**” section please include one of the four pick-up locations: Brampton, Mono, Guelph or Toronto. Once you have indicated your preferred pick-up location select **Continue**.

7. If everything looks good - select **Confirm Order** on the bottom right. If you missed adding your pick-up location you can also do it now in the “Comments About Your Order” field. You should get a confirmation e-mail of your purchase (which will not be finalized until receipt of your e-transfer payment).

8. Continue to your personal banking site and send your e-transfer payment (including HST) to treasurer@caledonbrucetrail.org. To assist our Treasurer, please Include your name and product code(s).

Then watch your e-mail for correspondence from our Fulfillment Team to make arrangements for pickup at your chosen location.





The next seven charcuterie boards were donated by Norm Randle. These one-of-a-kind hardwood boards are beautifully hand crafted with a natural Live-Edge and are finished with a food grade surface. They come in a variety of sizes and hardwoods supplied by Bruce Trail timbers.

After planing and sanding up to 400 grit, our woodworker extraordinaire Norm, raised the grain with water 3xs, then gave the boards a final sanding with 600 grit, which stabilized the grain. All the boards were then engraved with the CHBTC logo and finished with food safe mineral oil and a final coat of board butter, which is a mixture of mineral oil & bees wax.

This natural looking nest is crafted from Eastern White Cedar which is resistant to insects and decay, and ages beautifully. It is easy to take apart to clean. The 1 1/8" hole diameter is perfect for House Wrens, Winter Wrens and Bewick's Wrens or even Black-capped Chickadees.

Be sure to mount your wren birdhouse where predators such as cats, snakes or raccoons cannot easily reach the nest box. Do not add a perch to the box because this will allow birds such as starlings to land. You can place the nest box 5-10 feet above the ground, under the eaves or side of a building, or it can be hung freely from a wire or a tree limb, or hidden around shrubs.

Note: Bluebird lovers have gone to long lengths trying to discourage house wrens from using bluebird boxes. Just a note for you to ponder in case your bluebird-loving neighbours go postal on you when they find out you are installing a wren house. Wrens are cool little birds, and incredible singers and should be enjoyed too!

Then one coat of boiled linseed oil is applied, followed by one coat of Thompson Water Seal, so the rain beads and rolls off.




