### 2022 Caledon Hills Lopet

*Hockleycrest Ski Trails*

Once again this year, we are giving XC skiers a chance to earn the Caledon Hills Lopet badge. As we did last year, this will be a do-it-yourself event. The ski outing will be a little longer and more challenging than it was last year.



Here is what XC skiers have to do to get the badge:

- Go to the Hockleycrest ski trails, beginning at km 45.5, at the parking lot on the 5 Side Road of Mono.
- Ski to each of the 4 locations where a "Lopet" sign is displayed, and take a photo of yourself beside the sign.
- Send an email, with your 4 selfies attached, to *Dave Moule* at [dmhiker6@gmail.com](mailto:dmhiker6@gmail.com) requesting your badge.
- Dave will look at your photos to confirm you've completed the skiing requirements, and will arrange for delivery of the badge; there will be a \$20 payment for the badge.

Skiers may go by whatever route, and take the photos in whatever order they like, but they must go on skis; no walking or snowshoeing please.

The event is open as long as skiable conditions exist on the trails.
