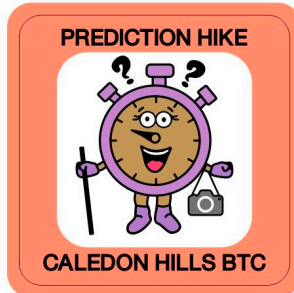
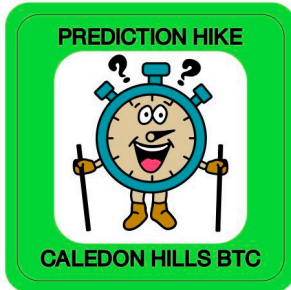


PREDICTION HIKE FUNDRAISER EVENT



Predication Hike Challenge, 2023

Whitetail Refuge Nature Reserve a BTC Protected Natural Area

Registration:

Register on the BTC Hike Schedule, starting March 30th at 7 am. <https://hikes.brucetrail.org/event/prediction-hike/2023-05-07/>

The registration fee is \$30.00 for adults and \$10.00 for children and students.

Choose to complete one of two predetermined hikes, a distance of approximately 7 km or 16 km. Be ready to provide a personal “to-the-second” prediction of how long it will take you to complete the distance on event day. Hike directions are noted below, if you wish to prehike.

Proceeds from the event will go towards trail maintenance and development in the Caledon Hills Bruce Trail section.

Directions: From ON-10 turn east onto Dufferin Rd 8/Mono Centre Rd. Drive for approximately 5.0 km. Park on the field on the east side of the road as directed by volunteers.

From Airport Road/County Rd 18 turn west onto Dufferin Rd 8/Mono Centre Rd. Drive for 7.5 km. Park on the field on the east side of the road as directed by volunteers.

Note: This meet up location has changed since first published in January.

Event Day:

Plan for a fantastic time hiking with family and friends in the northern section of our trail. Take lots of pictures, but remember NO peeking at time, pace, or distance technology during the hike. Participants hiking the longer distance can start between 8:30 and 8:45 and those hiking the shorter distance between 8:45 and 9:00. Light refreshments and beverages will be served at a mid location checkpoint and as part of a celebration at the end. Trail Marshalls will be situated along the trail to help with directions and other concerns.

The hikers in each distance category with the closest prediction to their actual time will be awarded a fabulous prize. Everyone will receive a spectacular collectible badge. This year's new badge will be the final one of the series.

Routes:

7 km"ish" Directions

From Dufferin Rd 8 head east on the access trail for approx 600 metres	0.60
Turn right onto the Springwater ST for 220 metres	0.22
Turn right onto MT for 1.80 kilometres.	1.80
Turn left onto Hockley Heights ST and continue for 170 metres.	0.17
Turn left onto Third Line and hike for 1.2 kilometres. (Checkpoint on Third Line 4.0 km into 7.35 km route.)	1.20
Turn left onto the Whitetail Refuge ST. Veer left and hike for 480 metres.	0.48
Turn right onto the the MT. Hike for 720 metres.	0.72
Turn left onto the Turnbull ST and hike for 920 metres.	0.92
Turn right onto the MT for 100 metres.	0.10
Veer right onto Springwater ST for approximately 100 metres	0.10
Turn right onto the access trail and head back to the start.	0.60

Total Distance: 7.35

16 km"ish" Directions

From Dufferin Rd 8 head east on the access trail for approx 600 metres	0.60
Turn right onto the Springwater ST for 220 metres	0.22
Turn right onto MT for 5.07 kilometres.	5.07
Turn right onto the Cam Snell ST for 2.20 kilometres.	2.20
Turn left at the MT and hike for 6.43 kilometres. (Checkpoint at Dunby Road Parking 10.5 km into 16.24 km route.)	6.43
Turn left onto the second/north access to the Turnbull ST and hike for 920 metres.	0.92
Turn right onto the MT for 100 metres.	0.10
Veer right onto Springwater ST for approximately 100 metres.	0.10
Turn right onto the access trail and head back to the start.	0.60

Total Distance: 16.24
